MOUNTAIN SKI RESORT

Ski resorts have become an integral part of winter recreation, offering thrilling experiences and scenic escapes for millions of enthusiasts worldwide. Once a niche activity, skiing and snowboarding have grown into mainstream winter sports, appealing to individuals and families alike. The allure of mountain adventures, coupled with modern infrastructure and diverse amenities, has transformed ski resorts into bustling hubs of activity during the colder months.

Globally, the popularity of ski tourism continues to rise, with the number of visitors increasing year after year. According to industry reports, this trend is fueled by a growing interest in active lifestyles, improved accessibility to ski destinations, and advancements in snowmaking technologies, which ensure longer seasons and more reliable conditions. As the global demand for winter tourism surges, ski resorts are expanding their offerings.

This report explores the development, significance, and future potential of ski resorts, with a special focus on Central Asia and Caucasus region growing prominence in the global winter tourism industry. It highlights key ski resorts in the region, challenges, and opportunities shaping the sector, providing valuable insights for stakeholders in this dynamic field.

KAZAKHSTAN



Ski resorts in Kazakhstan are becoming increasingly popular among tourists due to unique natural conditions and a rapidly developing infrastructure. The most in-demand resort is Shymbulak, attracting tens of thousands of visitors annually. However, its capacity is nearing its limit, highlighting the need for infrastructure expansion.

To enhance competitiveness and attract international tourists, the government of Kazakhstan is actively planning the development of mountain resorts. Key initiatives include:

- 1. Creating a unified skiing zone: Plans are underway to connect Shymbulak and Oi-Qaragai resorts with cable cars. This will result in a skiing area with over 100 km of trails, making it one of the largest ski zones in Central Asia.
- 2. Infrastructure development: The project involves increasing accommodation capacity, improving transportation accessibility, and expanding the range of services available to tourists.
- 3. New resorts: The government is considering building new ski resorts in the Turkestan, Almaty, and East Kazakhstan regions to reduce the load on existing resorts.

Kazakhstan's strategic focus on enhancing its ski tourism sector reflects a broader vision to diversify its economy and promote sustainable tourism. By integrating cutting-edge facilities with the natural beauty of its mountains, Kazakhstan is not only catering to ski enthusiasts but also creating opportunities for eco-tourism and cultural exploration.

With its blend of ambition, investment, and natural assets, Kazakhstan is poised to become a major hub for winter sports, offering experiences that rival those of traditional ski destinations in Europe and beyond.

Shymbulak

Shymbulak, the leading ski resort in Kazakhstan, continues to shine as the country's premier winter destination. Recently, it won multiple SKI BUSINESS AWARDS, affirming its excellence among CIS ski resorts.

To meet rising demand, Shymbulak plans to expand by connecting with Oi-Qaragai via a cable car, creating a 100 km skiing zone. The resort is also increasing its capacity to accommodate up to 15,000 visitors on peak days.

With these developments, Shymbulak is set to strengthen its position as a top destination for winter sports in Central Asia.

Tabagan is a cozy and budget-friendly ski resort known for its relaxed and family-oriented atmosphere. With its scenic surroundings and accessible slopes, it provides a charming alternative to larger, busier resorts, making it a favorite for casual visitors and families.

HOW TO GET THERE

Tabagan is located on the territory of the Talgar district of the Almaty region, near the Ile-Alatau State National Park. The distance from Almaty is 17 km. Its area is 55 hectares. The upper point of the slope is at around 1,650 m above sea level.

It is possible to get there by car from Almaty, moving from the city center along Al-Farabi Avenue, and then along the Talgar highway towards the Bayskiner. The journey will take about 50 minutes. A shuttle service is also available.



Ak-Bulak

Located east of Almaty, Ak-Bulak is the second most popular ski resort in Kazakhstan, following Shymbulak in visitor numbers. Its slopes are set on the picturesque Zailiysky Alatau ridge, offering well-maintained trails and all the necessary infrastructure for a comfortable and enjoyable skiing experience.

GEORGIA



Georgia is actively developing its ski resorts, attracting attention from the international sports community. In the 2024–2025 winter season, the resorts of Gudauri and Bakuriani will host stages of the World Cup in winter sports. Specifically, Gudauri will host snowboard cross events, while Bakuriani will feature moguls and ski cross competitions.

Additionally, in April 2024, Gudauri hosted the Youth World Snowboard Championship under the auspices of the International Ski and Snowboard Federation (FIS) for the first time. This event demonstrated the resort's compliance with international standards and highlighted its growing role on the global sports stage.

Moreover, Georgia is set to host the World Freeride Tour for the second time in Svaneti, at the Tetnuldi resort. This prestigious event reaches approximately 300 million viewers worldwide, highlighting Georgia's potential as a premier destination for winter sports.

These achievements strengthen the tourism industry in Georgia's mountain regions and enhance the country's appeal as a winter tourism hub. Hosting international competitions boosts infrastructure development and increases global awareness of Georgian ski resorts.

Gudauri

The Gudauri ski resort in Georgia continues to develop, attracting the attention of both local and foreign tourists. In October 2023, the construction of two new cable cars was announced, which will significantly improve the transport infrastructure of the resort and increase its attractiveness for winter sports enthusiasts.

HOW TO GET THERE

Gudauri is easy to reach by car or a minibus. The distance from Tbilisi is 121 km, which in good traffic conditions takes about 2.5 hours to cover. The road is well-tended in summer and in winter but in extreme weather conditions, reaching Gudauri is only possible with snow chains. The only major downside in terms of accessibility, is the fact that the highway E117 is also used by cargo trucks crossing in and out of Russia through Larsi Border Checkpoint. At times, the trucks cause traffic jams, which may delay a traveler to Gudauri by about half an hour.



Bakuriani

The Bakuriani ski resort in Georgia is actively preparing for the 2025 European Winter Youth Olympic Festival. In August 2024, a government commission was established under the leadership of Prime Minister Irakli Kobakhidze to coordinate preparations for this significant event.

In preparation for the festival, the Georgian government plans to invest about \$4 million in the development of Bakuriani's infrastructure. These funds will be used to modernize sports facilities, improve transport accessibility and improve the quality of service for resort guests.

HOW TO GET THERE

Bakuriani can be reached by cars and minibuses from Tbilisi. The roads are mostly in a good condition, but they get icy during Winter. Additionally, it is possible to take a train from Tbilisi to Borjomi and then travel on "kukushka" small train from Borjomi to Bakuriani.



Metsia: Hatsvali

Mestia is the touristy center of Svaneti. It rises 1,500 m above the sea level and is widely considered one of the gemstones of the Georgian alpine tourism. It preserves medieval Georgian traditions and architecture and commands some of the most breathraking views of the peaks of the western Caucasus. Hatsvali is a ski area in Mestia.

Mestia is 450km away from Tbilisi. It can be reached from the capital by a car or airplane since opening the airport named after King Tamar In Mestia in 2010. Regarding Hatsvali slope, it is possible to reach Hatsvali from Mestia via automobile road and a ski lift that accommodates six passengers. However, the chair lifts are not operating in summer and cars will be needed for transportation.

Metsia: Tetnuldi

Since opening in February 2016, the resort has become the second largest in the country after Gudauri, attracting the attention of both local and foreign tourists.

In March 2024, Tetnuldi will host the Freeride World Tour for the first time in the history of Georgia, which indicates the recognition of the resort in the international arena. The competition will be held from March 1-7, 2024, bringing together 50 outstanding athletes who will compete in freeride on difficult mountain slopes.

HOW TO GET THERE

Mestia is 450km away from Tbilisi. It can be reached from the capital by a car or airplane since opening the airport named after King Tamar In Mestia in 2010.Notably, infrastructure is limited in Tetnuldi as in Hatsvali, so visitors typically rely on Mestia for basic provisions. Still, 15km is not a short way to go and roads in Winter are not the safest in Svaneti. Tetnuldi is not an easily accessible ski resort and that might be seriously affecting apparent demand on its trails.



Goderdzi

The Goderdzi Ski Resort, located in Adjara, Georgia, is actively developing, offering new opportunities for tourists. In 2024, 28 investment projects with a total value of 200 million lari are being implemented at the resort, which will create up to 1,500 places to accommodate guests and about 1,000 new jobs. As part of the infrastructure development, it is planned to build an additional cable car and new ski slopes.

HOW TO GET THERE

Goderdzi can be reached by car from Tbilisi, via Akhaltsikhe and Zarzma, but this road is usually closed in Winter as it crosses high passes that are not maintained regularly and can be hazardous under snowy and freezing conditions. This leaves visitors to travel through Batumi, which for some means driving about six hours to Batumi and then a couple more hours to Goderdzi, making for a large roundabout trip; or a flight to Batumi and then a drive to Goderdzi. Either way, Goderdzi, much like Mestia ski resorts, suffers from lack of accessibility, which likely reflects upon the number of visitors seen here.

KYRGYZSTAN



Ski resorts are actively developing in Kyrgyzstan, aimed at attracting tourists and strengthening the country's economy. Recently, President Sadyr Zhaparov stressed the strategic importance of the Three Peaks project, which includes the construction of all-season mountain resorts in Issyk-Kul region. It is expected that these resorts will be able to receive up to 850 thousand tourists per year and operate 10 months a year. Within the framework of this project, the construction of the Karkyra ski eco-town has begun. In addition, the projects "Three Peaks" and "Baitik Mountain Resort" in the Chui region aimed at attracting investments in the tourism industry of Kyrgyzstan were presented at the SOR-29 international exhibition in Baku.

Earlier, in April 2024, the French company Société des Trois Vallées (S3V), known for working with the Courchevel resort, announced plans to implement the Three Peaks ski cluster in Kyrgyzstan. This project will be the largest in Central Asia and will require investments of 165 million euros.

Thus, the development of ski resorts in Kyrgyzstan is aimed at creating a modern tourist infrastructure capable of attracting a significant number of tourists and contributing to the economic growth of the country.

Karakol

Karakol is one of the largest ski resorts in the country. Initially, it was the main base for the training of athletes of the USSR winter sport. The ski base is located near the city of Karakol. At the moment, the base has tracks with a length of 20 km, with different duration and level of complexity.

HOW TO GET THERE

This winter resort is located 430 km from Manas International Airport. The village stands at an altitude of 2.3 km, on the territory of a nature reserve, so it is required to pay a small amount for entry in local currency, soms (KGS). It is also possible to order a transfer at Manas airport, which will take directly to the resort. From Almaty, the distance to Karakol is 378 km, and the journey will take about 5.5 hours.

Too-Ashuu is a mountain pass on the southern slope of which the ski base of the same name is located. In addition to descent services, the base of Ashuu offers an ice rink, as well as extreme Heli Skiing, when visitors are taken to the unequipped slopes by helicopter.
